## Strong Housing Market; Down from Spring Frenzy



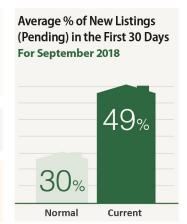
77 percent of sales activity is below \$500,000 on the Westside of Portland. In this range, we have a shortage of unsold listings and a surge level of sales activity intensity.

From \$500,000 to 750,000, there is a shortage of unsold listings and a healthy sales activity intensity. There is healthy buyer activity above \$750,000.

The number one key indicator of a strong housing market, job growth, remains very strong in the Portland area. Additionally, interest rates are currently in the upper four percent. However, interest rates are projected to go higher in 2019.
