Housing Market Remains Strong

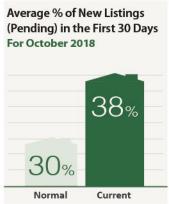


In October, the more affordable and mid-price ranges maintained a strong level of sales activity intensity for new listings selling in the first 30 days. Moving forward into the winter months, we normally see slightly higher pending sales activity than the number of new listings, because monthly new listing numbers dip down to approximately 40 to 60 percent compared to summer months. Inventory remains at a shortage level in the more affordable and mid-price ranges. Currently, the high-end and luxury markets are seeing selective buyer activity.

The fundamentals of the housing market remain positive. For those looking to sell, it's okay to buy and sell within same-market timing, but it's still important to be buyer-ready to get the home of your choice. In many cases this winter, people can purchase a home with a home-to-sell contingency, which gives buyers the opportunity to sell their current home.
